To be admitted applicants must be certified in one of the Career and Technical Education fields listed above, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, be accepted to MSU Graduate School, hold a bachelor's degree from accredited university, have at least three years of successful teaching experience in career and technical education, and hold a valid Kentucky teaching certificate. The program must be **PREPLANNED*** with one's advisor and shall consist of 24 semester hours of graduate level course work.

Exit assessments: passing score on the School Leaders Licensure Assessment (SLLA), passing score on the Kentucky Principal Examination, and verification of completing all program coursework with a grade of B or better.
