The M.M.E. degree is designed to fulfill course requirements for Rank II classification in Kentucky. The program requires a GPA of 3.0 or higher and a music teaching certification. The program must be preplanned with one's advisor and shall consist of 30 hours of graduate level course work. The program must be completed within eight years of the time the student initially enrolls in any course applicable to the program. The student's progress will be continuously assessed throughout the program. Students must pass a Functional Keyboard Proficiency Exam. A written comprehensive examination is required. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 is required for candidacy and for graduation. **Exit Assessment:** Comprehensive Exam.
